

what is a pharisees

if you use a secular dictionary to look up this word

you would be trusting those that don't believe in the bible

you should always try to find the definition within the verses of the bible

**slide**

these 6 verses are the best to define what is a pharisees //

the yellow highlighted words are the clues i will use //

the 1<sup>st</sup> verse is the biggest clue // for it is telling us they **seated themselves in the chair of Moses.**

Moses, was a Judge and relayed our FATHER'S COMMANDS to our FATHER'S NATION call Israel

knowing this // the word pharisees **are judges!**

Which in the 2<sup>nd</sup> verse tells us // they were from everywhere in the land for israelis being ruled over // that seems to also say they are judges

the 3<sup>rd</sup> verse groups them with lawyers

the 4<sup>th</sup> verse gives us information saying they knew many subjects // I would say Laws // because there a many verses that they are asking Jesus about our FATHER'S LAWS

and in the 5<sup>th</sup> verse they are asking about our FATHER'S COMMANDMENT

the last verse is how a judge would talk

**slide**

in this slide // I replace the word **pharisees** with the word **judges** // the verses are now giving a more truthful meaning to the reader

but can I do this to other verses?

are there more clues to say they are judges?

**slide**

yes // the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> verses say they are **rulers** over their people

verse 3 says they can council with the chief priests

now the chief priests are // the 12 tribes priests **and** the high priest **AND** by our FATHER'S LAW these are the only priests with their attendants that are able to enter the gates to the courtyard of our FATHER'S HOUSE

now the 2 verses that have underlined words // **tell us** that had authority to kick out anyone forever from going to the place of worship // **and** they sat in the front row seats

let me show you 2 bible concordances // 1 is Strong's and the other is the nasb 1977 concordance

slide

here are both concordances, the top one is Strong's // notice the red underlined words // strong's says they are **a separatist** and the nasb says **a member of a sect**

which means the definition in both concordances are wrong!

again, these underlined words give us the opposite // they are people who set in the front seats in their place of worship // and they can kickout a worshiper for confessing Jesus is their King

and the **last** 3 verses // they even worked with the tribes priests and with their power they could send out their officers to arrest Jesus // yes they were rulers // but as judges so they did rule over all the common people

slide

this slide is the cleaned up editing using the word judges // which when reading these verses gives us that meaning they were in great authority over the israelis.

to me // this tells me the romans let them judge their own people up to a point // but they didn't have the romans authority for putting someone to death // but had a strong hand in ruling over their people

next i found only 5 verses in the gospels that have the word sadducees // and they have the word pharisees // what does the word sadducees mean

and the 1<sup>st</sup> verse says they are **with the judges** and are a **group** of vipers

the last 3 verses all say they are all giving out teachings against our FATHER

**what word** could i substitute for the word sadducees to better help the reader ?

how about the words **their officers**

that ties them together as a group // but having a lesser authority than the judges themselves // but still their people had to listen to them

so what does the concordances say about the word sadducees

here are the 2 concordances and they both got it wrong again

here are 8 more verses **that say** the so called pharisees know the laws // and wanted Jesus to answer them to know if Jesus knew the Laws like they did

and the last verse they even went into see pilate //

they weren't some off chute sect // they are their judges! with authority over their people and had officers to have authority over their people
