### Matthew 4:23 (NASB 1977)

And *Jesus* was going about in all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, and proclaiming the **gospel** of the kingdom, and healing every kind of disease and every kind of sickness among the people.

## Matthew 9:35 (NASB)

And Jesus was going about all the cities and the villages, teaching in their synagogues, and proclaiming the **gospel** of the kingdom, and healing every kind of disease and every kind of sickness.

### Matthew 11:5 (NASB)

the BLIND RECEIVE SIGHT and the lame walk, the lepers are cleansed and the deaf hear, and the dead are raised up, and the POOR HAVE THE **GOSPEL** PREACHED TO THEM.

## Matthew 24:14 (NASB)

"And this **gospel** of the kingdom shall be preached in the whole world for a witness to all the nations, and then the end shall come.

## Matthew 26:13 (NASB)

"Truly I say to you, wherever this **gospel** is preached in the whole world, what this woman has done shall also be spoken of in memory of her."

### Mark 1:1 (NASB)

The beginning of the **gospel** of Jesus Christ, the Son of God.

# Mark 1:14 (NASB)

And after John had been taken into custody, Jesus came into Galilee, preaching the **gospel** of God.

## Mark 1:15 (NASB)

and saying, "The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand; repent and believe in the **gospel."** 

## Mark 13:10 (NASB)

"And the **gospel** must first be preached to all the nations.

## Mark 14:9 (NASB)

"And truly I say to you, wherever the **gospel** is preached in the whole world, that also which this woman has done shall be spoken of in memory of her."

### Mark 16:15 (NASB)

And He said to them, "Go into all the world and preach the gospel to all creation.

#### Luke 3:18 (NASB)

So with many other exhortations also he preached the **gospel** to the people.

## Luke 4:18 (NASB)

"THE SPIRIT OF THE LORD IS UPON ME, BECAUSE HE ANOINTED ME TO PREACH THE **GOSPEL** TO THE POOR. HE HAS SENT ME TO PROCLAIM RELEASE TO THE CAPTIVES, AND RECOVERY OF SIGHT TO THE BLIND, TO SET FREE THOSE WHO ARE DOWNTRODDEN.

## Luke 7:22 (NASB)

And He answered and said to them, "Go and report to John what you have seen and heard: *the* BLIND RECEIVE SIGHT, *the* lame walk, *the* lepers are cleansed, and *the* deaf hear, *the* dead are raised up, *the* POOR HAVE THE **GOSPEL** PREACHED TO THEM.

## Luke 9:6 (NASB)

And departing, they *began* going about among the villages, preaching the **gospel**, and healing everywhere.

## Luke 16:16 (NASB)

"The Law and the Prophets were proclaimed until John; since then the **gospel** of the kingdom of God is preached, and everyone is forcing his way into it.

# Luke 20:1 (NASB)

And it came about on one of the days while He was teaching the people in the temple and preaching the **gospel**, that the chief priests and the scribes with the elders confronted *Him*,

# Acts 8:25 (NASB)

And so, when they had solemnly testified and spoken the word of the Lord, they started back to Jerusalem, and were preaching the **gospel** to many villages of the Samaritans.

## Acts 8:40 (NASB)

But Philip found himself at Azotus; and as he passed through he kept preaching the **gospel** to all the cities, until he came to Caesarea.

#### Acts 14:7 (NASB)

and there they continued to preach the gospel.

# Acts 14:15 (NASB)

and saying, "Men, why are you doing these things? We are also men of the same nature as you, and preach the **gospel** to you in order that you should turn from these vain things to a

living God, WHO MADE THE HEAVEN AND THE EARTH AND THE SEA, AND ALL THAT IS IN THEM.

# Acts 14:21 (NASB)

And after they had preached the **gospel** to that city and had made many disciples, they returned to Lystra and to Iconium and to Antioch,

# Acts 15:7 (NASB)

And after there had been much debate, Peter stood up and said to them, "Brethren, you know that in the early days God made a choice among you, that by my mouth the Gentiles should hear the word of the **gospel** and believe.

# Acts 16:10 (NASB)

And when he had seen the vision, immediately we sought to go into Macedonia, concluding that God had called us to preach the **gospel** to them.

# Acts 20:24 (NASB)

"But I do not consider my life of any account as dear to myself, in order that I may finish my course, and the ministry which I received from the Lord Jesus, to testify solemnly of the **gospel** of the grace of God.

## Romans 1:1 (NASB)

Paul, a bond-servant of Christ Jesus, called as an apostle, set apart for the gospel of God,

## Romans 1:9 (NASB)

For God, whom I serve in my spirit in the *preaching of the* **gospel** of His Son, is my witness as to how unceasingly I make mention of you,

#### Romans 1:15 (NASB)

Thus, for my part, I am eager to preach the **gospel** to you also who are in Rome.

#### Romans 1:16 (NASB)

For I am not ashamed of the **gospel**, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek.

### Romans 2:16 (NASB)

on the day when, according to my **gospel**, God will judge the secrets of men through Christ Jesus.

# Romans 11:28 (NASB)

From the standpoint of the **gospel** they are enemies for your sake, but from the standpoint of *God's* choice they are beloved for the sake of the fathers;

## Romans 15:16 (NASB)

to be a minister of Christ Jesus to the Gentiles, ministering as a priest the **gospel** of God, that *my* offering of the Gentiles might become acceptable, sanctified by the Holy Spirit.

#### Romans 15:19 (NASB)

in the power of signs and wonders, in the power of the Spirit; so that from Jerusalem and round about as far as Illyricum I have fully preached the **gospel** of Christ.

### Romans 15:20 (NASB)

And thus I aspired to preach the **gospel**, not where Christ was *already* named, that I might not build upon another man's foundation;

### Romans 16:25 (NASB)

Now to Him who is able to establish you according to my **gospel** and the preaching of Jesus Christ, according to the revelation of the mystery which has been kept secret for long ages past,

### 1 Corinthians 1:17 (NASB)

For Christ did not send me to baptize, but to preach the **gospel**, not in cleverness of speech, that the cross of Christ should not be made void.

# 1 Corinthians 4:15 (NASB)

For if you were to have countless tutors in Christ, yet *you would* not *have* many fathers; for in Christ Jesus I became your father through the **gospel.** 

# 1 Corinthians 9:12 (NASB)

If others share the right over you, do we not more? Nevertheless, we did not use this right, but we endure all things, that we may cause no hindrance to the **gospel** of Christ.

## 1 Corinthians 9:14 (NASB)

So also the Lord directed those who proclaim the **gospel** to get their living from the **gospel**.

### 1 Corinthians 9:16 (NASB)

For if I preach the **gospel**, I have nothing to boast of, for I am under compulsion; for woe is me if I do not preach the **gospel**.

### 1 Corinthians 9:18 (NASB)

What then is my reward? That, when I preach the **gospel**, I may offer the **gospel** without charge, so as not to make full use of my right in the **gospel**.

#### 1 Corinthians 9:23 (NASB)

And I do all things for the sake of the gospel, that I may become a fellow partaker of it.

#### 1 Corinthians 15:1 (NASB)

Now I make known to you, brethren, the **gospel** which I preached to you, which also you received, in which also you stand,

### 2 Corinthians 2:12 (NASB)

Now when I came to Troas for the **gospel** of Christ and when a door was opened for me in the Lord,

## 2 Corinthians 4:3 (NASB)

And even if our **gospel** is veiled, it is veiled to those who are perishing,

# 2 Corinthians 4:4 (NASB)

in whose case the god of this world has blinded the minds of the unbelieving, that they might not see the light of the **gospel** of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God.

# 2 Corinthians 8:18 (NASB)

And we have sent along with him the brother whose fame in the things of the gospel has

spread through all the churches;

### 2 Corinthians 9:13 (NASB)

Because of the proof given by this ministry they will glorify God for *your* obedience to your confession of the **gospel** of Christ, and for the liberality of your contribution to them and to all,

## 2 Corinthians 10:14 (NASB)

For we are not overextending ourselves, as if we did not reach to you, for we were the first to come even as far as you in the **gospel** of Christ;

### 2 Corinthians 10:16 (NASB)

so as to preach the **gospel** even to the regions beyond you, *and* not to boast in what has been accomplished in the sphere of another.

## 2 Corinthians 11:4 (NASB)

For if one comes and preaches another Jesus whom we have not preached, or you receive a different spirit which you have not received, or a different **gospel** which you have not accepted, you bear *this* beautifully.

# 2 Corinthians 11:7 (NASB)

Or did I commit a sin in humbling myself that you might be exalted, because I preached the **gospel** of God to you without charge?

# Galatians 1:6 (NASB)

I am amazed that you are so quickly deserting Him who called you by the grace of Christ, for a different **gospel**;

### Galatians 1:7 (NASB)

which is *really* not another; only there are some who are disturbing you, and want to distort the **gospel** of Christ.

#### Galatians 1:8 (NASB)

But even though we, or an angel from heaven, should preach to you a **gospel** contrary to that which we have preached to you, let him be accursed.

### Galatians 1:9 (NASB)

As we have said before, so I say again now, if any man is preaching to you a **gospel** contrary to that which you received, let him be accursed.

## Galatians 1:11 (NASB)

For I would have you know, brethren, that the **gospel** which was preached by me is not according to man.

#### Galatians 2:2 (NASB)

And it was because of a revelation that I went up; and I submitted to them the **gospel** which I preach among the Gentiles, but *I did so* in private to those who were of reputation, for fear that I might be running, or had run, in vain.

## Galatians 2:5 (NASB)

But we did not yield in subjection to them for even an hour, so that the truth of the **gospel** might remain with you.

### Galatians 2:7 (NASB)

But on the contrary, seeing that I had been entrusted with the **gospel** to the uncircumcised, just as Peter *had been* to the circumcised

### Galatians 2:14 (NASB)

But when I saw that they were not straightforward about the truth of the **gospel**, I said to Cephas in the presence of all, "If you, being a Jew, live like the Gentiles and not like the Jews, how *is it that* you compel the Gentiles to live like Jews?

### Galatians 3:8 (NASB)

And the Scripture, foreseeing that God would justify the Gentiles by faith, preached the **gospel** beforehand to Abraham, saying, "ALL THE NATIONS SHALL BE BLESSED IN YOU."

## Galatians 4:13 (NASB)

but you know that it was because of a bodily illness that I preached the **gospel** to you the first time;

## Ephesians 1:13 (NASB)

In Him, you also, after listening to the message of truth, the **gospel** of your salvation-- having also believed, you were sealed in Him with the Holy Spirit of promise,

# Ephesians 3:6 (NASB)

to be specific, that the Gentiles are fellow heirs and fellow members of the body, and fellow partakers of the promise in Christ Jesus through the **gospel**,

# Ephesians 6:15 (NASB)

and having shod YOUR FEET WITH THE PREPARATION OF THE GOSPEL OF PEACE;

## Ephesians 6:19 (NASB)

and *pray* on my behalf, that utterance may be given to me in the opening of my mouth, to make known with boldness the mystery of the **gospel**,

## Philippians 1:5 (NASB)

in view of your participation in the **gospel** from the first day until now.

# Philippians 1:7 (NASB)

For it is only right for me to feel this way about you all, because I have you in my heart, since both in my imprisonment and in the defense and confirmation of the **gospel**, you all are partakers of grace with me.

### Philippians 1:12 (NASB)

Now I want you to know, brethren, that my circumstances have turned out for the greater progress of the **gospel**,

# Philippians 1:16 (NASB)

the latter do it out of love, knowing that I am appointed for the defense of the **gospel**;

## Philippians 1:27 (NASB)

Only conduct yourselves in a manner worthy of the **gospel** of Christ; so that whether I come and see you or remain absent, I may hear of you that you are standing firm in one spirit, with

one mind striving together for the faith of the **gospel**;

# Philippians 2:22 (NASB)

But you know of his proven worth that he served with me in the furtherance of the **gospel** like a child *serving* his father.

## Philippians 4:3 (NASB)

Indeed, true comrade, I ask you also to help these women who have shared my struggle in *the cause of* the **gospel**, together with Clement also, and the rest of my fellow workers, whose names are in the book of life.

# Philippians 4:15 (NASB)

And you yourselves also know, Philippians, that at the first preaching of the **gospel,** after I departed from Macedonia, no church shared with me in the matter of giving and receiving but you alone;

# Colossians 1:5 (NASB)

because of the hope laid up for you in heaven, of which you previously heard in the word of truth, the **gospel**,

## Colossians 1:23 (NASB)

if indeed you continue in the faith firmly established and steadfast, and not moved away from the hope of the **gospel** that you have heard, which was proclaimed in all creation under heaven, and of which I, Paul, was made a minister.

### 1 Thessalonians 1:5 (NASB)

for our **gospel** did not come to you in word only, but also in power and in the Holy Spirit and with full conviction; just as you know what kind of men we proved to be among you for your sake.

#### 1 Thessalonians 2:2 (NASB)

but after we had already suffered and been mistreated in Philippi, as you know, we had the boldness in our God to speak to you the **gospel** of God amid much opposition.

#### 1 Thessalonians 2:4 (NASB)

but just as we have been approved by God to be entrusted with the **gospel**, so we speak, not as pleasing men but God, who examines our hearts.

### 1 Thessalonians 2:8 (NASB)

Having thus a fond affection for you, we were well-pleased to impart to you not only the **gospel** of God but also our own lives, because you had become very dear to us.

## 1 Thessalonians 2:9 (NASB)

For you recall, brethren, our labor and hardship, *how* working night and day so as not to be a burden to any of you, we proclaimed to you the **gospel** of God.

# 1 Thessalonians 3:2 (NASB)

and we sent Timothy, our brother and God's fellow worker in the **gospel** of Christ, to strengthen and encourage you as to your faith,

# 2 Thessalonians 1:8 (NASB)

dealing out retribution to those who do not know God and to those who do not obey the **gospel** of our Lord Jesus.

# 2 Thessalonians 2:14 (NASB)

And it was for this He called you through our **gospel**, that you may gain the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ.

## 1 Timothy 1:11 (NASB)

according to the glorious gospel of the blessed God, with which I have been entrusted.

# 2 Timothy 1:8 (NASB)

Therefore do not be ashamed of the testimony of our Lord, or of me His prisoner; but join with *me* in suffering for the **gospel** according to the power of God,

## 2 Timothy 1:10 (NASB)

but now has been revealed by the appearing of our Savior Christ Jesus, who abolished death, and brought life and immortality to light through the **gospel**,

# 2 Timothy 2:8 (NASB)

Remember Jesus Christ, risen from the dead, descendant of David, according to my gospel,

# Philemon 1:13 (NASB)

whom I wished to keep with me, that in your behalf he might minister to me in my imprisonment for the **gospel**;

#### 1 Peter 1:12 (NASB)

It was revealed to them that they were not serving themselves, but you, in these things which now have been announced to you through those who preached the **gospel** to you by the Holy Spirit sent from heaven-- things into which angels long to look.

#### 1 Peter 4:6 (NASB)

For the **gospel** has for this purpose been preached even to those who are dead, that though they are judged in the flesh as men, they may live in the spirit according to *the will of* God.

## 1 Peter 4:17 (NASB)

For *it is* time for judgment to begin with the household of God; and if *it begins* with us first, what *will be* the outcome for those who do not obey the **gospel** of God?

### Revelation 14:6 (NASB)

And I saw another angel flying in midheaven, having an eternal **gospel** to preach to those who live on the earth, and to every nation and tribe and tongue and people;
