

pharisees verses

Matthew 5:20 (NASB)

"For I say to you, that unless your righteousness surpasses *that* of the scribes and **Pharisees**, you shall not enter the kingdom of heaven.

Matthew 9:11 (NASB)

And when the **Pharisees** saw *this*, they said to His disciples, "Why is your Teacher eating with the tax-gatherers and sinners?"

Matthew 9:14 (NASB)

Then the disciples of John came[^] to Him, saying, "Why do we and the **Pharisees** fast, but Your disciples do not fast?"

Matthew 9:34 (NASB)

But the **Pharisees** were saying, "He casts out the demons by the ruler of the demons."

Matthew 12:24 (NASB)

But when the **Pharisees** heard it, they said, "This man casts out demons only by Beelzebul the ruler of the demons."

Matthew 12:2 (NASB)

But when the **Pharisees** saw it, they said to Him, "Behold, Your disciples do what is not lawful to do on a Sabbath."

Matthew 12:14 (NASB)

But the **Pharisees** went out, and counseled together against Him, as *to* how they might destroy Him.

Matthew 12:38 (NASB)

Then some of the scribes and **Pharisees** answered Him, saying, "Teacher, we want to see a sign from You."

Matthew 15:1 (NASB)

Then some **Pharisees** and scribes came[^] to Jesus from Jerusalem, saying,

Matthew 15:12 (NASB)

Then the disciples came[^] and said[^] to Him, "Do You know that the **Pharisees** were offended when they heard this statement?"

Matthew 3:7 (NASB)

But when he saw many of the **Pharisees** and **Sadducees** coming for baptism, he said to them, "You brood of vipers, who warned you to flee from the wrath to come?"

Matthew 16:1 (NASB)

And the **Pharisees** and **Sadducees** came up, and testing Him asked Him to show them a sign from heaven.

Matthew 16:6 (NASB)

And Jesus said to them, "**Watch out and beware of the leaven of the Pharisees and Sadducees.**"

Matthew 16:11 (NASB)

"**How is it that you do not understand that I did not speak to you concerning bread? But beware of the leaven of the Pharisees and Sadducees.**"

Matthew 16:12 (NASB)

Then they understood that He did not say to beware of the leaven of bread, but of the teaching of the **Pharisees** and **Sadducees**.

Matthew 19:3 (NASB)

And *some* **Pharisees** came to Him, testing Him, and saying, "Is it lawful *for a man* to divorce his wife for any cause at all?"

Matthew 21:45 (NASB)

And when the chief priests and the **Pharisees** heard His parables, they understood that He was speaking about them.

Matthew 22:15 (NASB)

Then the **Pharisees** went and counseled together how they might trap Him in what He said.

Matthew 22:34 (NASB)

But when the **Pharisees** heard that He had put the Sadducees to silence, they gathered themselves together.

Matthew 22:41 (NASB)

Now while the **Pharisees** were gathered together, Jesus asked them a question,

Matthew 23:2 (NASB)

saying, "**The scribes and the Pharisees** have seated themselves in the chair of Moses;

Matthew 23:13 (NASB)

"**But woe to you, scribes and Pharisees**, hypocrites, because you shut off the kingdom of heaven from men; for you do not enter in yourselves, nor do you allow those who are entering to go in.

Matthew 23:14 (NASB)

<"**Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees**, hypocrites, because you devour widows' houses, even while for a pretense you make long prayers; therefore you shall receive greater condemnation.>

Matthew 23:15 (NASB)

"**Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees**, hypocrites, because you travel about on sea and land to make one proselyte; and when he becomes one, you make him twice as much a son of hell as yourselves.

Matthew 23:23 (NASB)

"**Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees**, hypocrites! For you tithe mint and dill and cummin, and have neglected the weightier provisions of the law: justice and mercy and faithfulness; but these are the things you should have done without neglecting the others.

Matthew 23:25 (NASB)

"**Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees**, hypocrites! For you clean the outside of the cup and of the dish, but inside they are full of robbery and self-indulgence.

Matthew 23:27 (NASB)

"**Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees**, hypocrites! For you are like whitewashed tombs which on the outside appear beautiful, but inside they are full of dead men's bones and all uncleanness.

Matthew 23:29 (NASB)

"**Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees**, hypocrites! For you build the tombs of the prophets and adorn the monuments of the righteous,

Matthew 27:62 (NASB)

Now on the next day, which is *the one* after the preparation, the chief priests and the **Pharisees** gathered together with Pilate,

Mark 2:16 (NASB)

And when the scribes of the **Pharisees** saw that He was eating with the sinners and tax-gatherers, they *began* saying to His disciples, "Why is He eating and drinking with tax-gatherers and sinners?"

Mark 2:18 (NASB)

And John's disciples and the **Pharisees** were fasting; and they came[^] and said[^] to Him, "Why do John's disciples and the disciples of the **Pharisees** fast, but Your disciples do not fast?"

Mark 2:24 (NASB)

And the **Pharisees** were saying to Him, "See here, why are they doing what is not lawful on the Sabbath?"

Mark 3:6 (NASB)

And the **Pharisees** went out and immediately *began* taking counsel with the Herodians against Him, as *to* how they might destroy Him.

Mark 7:1 (NASB)

And the **Pharisees** and some of the scribes gathered together around Him when they had come from Jerusalem,

Mark 7:3 (NASB)

(For the **Pharisees** and all the Jews do not eat unless they carefully wash their hands, *thus* observing the traditions

of the elders;

Mark 7:5 (NASB)

And the **Pharisees** and the scribes asked Him, "Why do Your disciples not walk according to the tradition of the elders, but eat their bread with impure hands?"

Mark 8:11 (NASB)

And the **Pharisees** came out and began to argue with Him, seeking from Him a sign from heaven, to test Him.

Mark 8:15 (NASB)

And He was giving orders to them, saying, "**Watch out! Beware of the leaven of the Pharisees and the leaven of Herod.**"

Mark 10:2 (NASB)

And *some* **Pharisees** came up to Him, testing Him, and *began* to question Him whether it was lawful for a man to divorce a wife.

Mark 12:13 (NASB)

And they sent some of the **Pharisees** and Herodians to Him, in order to trap Him in a statement.

Luke 5:17 (NASB)

And it came about one day that He was teaching; and there were *some* **Pharisees** and teachers of the law sitting *there*, who had come from every village of Galilee and Judea and *from* Jerusalem; and the power of the Lord was *present* for Him to perform healing.

Luke 5:21 (NASB)

And the scribes and the **Pharisees** began to reason, saying, "Who is this *man* who speaks blasphemies? Who can forgive sins, but God alone?"

Luke 5:30 (NASB)

And the **Pharisees** and their scribes *began* grumbling at His disciples, saying, "Why do you eat and drink with the tax-gatherers and sinners?"

Luke 5:33 (NASB)

And they said to Him, "The disciples of John often fast and offer prayers; the *disciples* of the **Pharisees** also do the same; but Yours eat and drink."

Luke 6:2 (NASB)

But some of the **Pharisees** said, "Why do you do what is not lawful on the Sabbath?"

Luke 6:7 (NASB)

And the scribes and the **Pharisees** were watching Him closely, *to see* if He healed on the Sabbath, in order that they might find *reason* to accuse Him.

Luke 7:30 (NASB)

But the **Pharisees** and the lawyers rejected God's purpose for themselves, not having been baptized by John.

Luke 7:36 (NASB)

Now one of the **Pharisees** was requesting Him to dine with him. And He entered the Pharisee's house, and reclined *at the table*.

Luke 11:39 (NASB)

But the Lord said to him, "**Now you Pharisees clean the outside of the cup and of the platter; but inside of you, you are full of robbery and wickedness.**"

Luke 11:42 (NASB)

"**But woe to you Pharisees! For you pay tithes of mint and rue and every kind of garden herb, and yet disregard justice and the love of God; but these are the things you should have done without neglecting the others.**"

Luke 11:43 (NASB)

"**Woe to you Pharisees! For you love the front seats in the synagogues, and the respectful greetings in the market places.**"

Luke 11:53 (NASB)

And when He left there, the scribes and the **Pharisees** began to be very hostile and to question Him closely on many subjects,

Luke 12:1 (NASB)

.... He began saying to His disciples first of all, "**Beware of the leaven of the Pharisees, which is hypocrisy.**"

Luke 13:31 (NASB)

Just at that time some **Pharisees** came up, saying to Him, "Go away and depart from here, for Herod wants to kill You."

Luke 14:1 (NASB)

And it came about when He went into the house of one of the leaders of the **Pharisees** on *the* Sabbath to eat bread, that they were watching Him closely.

Luke 14:3 (NASB)

And Jesus answered and spoke to the lawyers and **Pharisees**, saying, "**Is it lawful to heal on the Sabbath, or not?**"

Luke 15:2 (NASB)

And both the **Pharisees** and the scribes *began* to grumble, saying, "This man receives sinners and eats with them."

Luke 16:14 (NASB)

Now the **Pharisees**, who were lovers of money, were listening to all these things, and they were scoffing at Him.

Luke 17:20 (NASB)

Now having been questioned by the **Pharisees** as to when the kingdom of God was coming, He answered them and said, "**The kingdom of God is not coming with signs to be observed;**"

Luke 19:39 (NASB)

And some of the **Pharisees** in the multitude said to Him, "Teacher, rebuke Your disciples."

John 1:24 (NASB)

Now they had been sent from the **Pharisees**.

John 3:1 (NASB)

Now there was a man of the **Pharisees**, named Nicodemus, a ruler of the Jews;

John 4:1 (NASB)

When therefore the Lord knew that the **Pharisees** had heard that Jesus was making and baptizing more disciples than John

John 7:32 (NASB)

The **Pharisees** heard the multitude muttering these things about Him; and the chief priests and the **Pharisees** sent officers to seize Him.

John 7:45 (NASB)

The officers therefore came to the chief priests and **Pharisees**, and they said to them, "Why did you not bring Him?"

John 7:47 (NASB)

The **Pharisees** therefore answered them, "You have not also been led astray, have you?"

John 7:48 (NASB)

"No one of the rulers or **Pharisees** has believed in Him, has he?"

John 8:3 (NASB)

And the scribes and the **Pharisees** brought^a a woman caught in adultery, and having set her in the midst,

John 8:13 (NASB)

The **Pharisees** therefore said to Him, "You are bearing witness of Yourself; Your witness is not true."

John 9:13 (NASB)

They brought[^] to the **Pharisees** him who was formerly blind.

John 9:15 (NASB)

Again, therefore, the **Pharisees** also were asking him how he received his sight. And he said to them, "He applied clay to my eyes, and I washed, and I see."

John 9:16 (NASB)

Therefore some of the **Pharisees** were saying, "This man is not from God, because He does not keep the Sabbath." But others were saying, "How can a man who is a sinner perform such signs?" And there was a division among them.

John 9:40 (NASB)

Those of the **Pharisees** who were with Him heard these things, and said to Him, "We are not blind too, are we?"

John 11:46 (NASB)

But some of them went away to the **Pharisees**, and told them the things which Jesus had done.

John 11:47 (NASB)

Therefore the chief priests and the **Pharisees** convened a council, and were saying, "What are we doing? For this man is performing many signs.

John 11:57 (NASB)

Now the chief priests and the **Pharisees** had given orders that if anyone knew where He was, he should report it, that they might seize Him.

John 12:19 (NASB)

The **Pharisees** therefore said to one another, "You see that you are not doing any good; look, the world has gone after Him."

John 12:42 (NASB)

Nevertheless many even of the rulers believed in Him, but because of the **Pharisees** they were not confessing *Him*, lest they should be put out of the synagogue;

John 18:3 (NASB)

Judas then, having received the *Roman* cohort, and officers from the chief priests and the **Pharisees**, came there with lanterns and torches and weapons.
